### Informal Minutes

#### 1. Ad Hoc purposes

#### 2. Polling Firms

Group agrees that we should get at least three quotes, including at least one from each side of the aisle. MR/DBR would reach out (mail, email, phone call, door knocking) to every parcel owner in an attempt to get input.

Suggestion that we ask Supv. Joan Hartmann who she has seen used in the community. The group then talks about meeting with Supv. Hartmann's office.

#### 3. Communications Firms

Need to get more quotes, but basic effort looks right.

Group discusses the desire for an assessment engineer to break it down to each parcel owner

The group discusses need for a work plan. GM Savage agrees to bring the items he knows about the Prop 218 to the next meeting so the group can put together a plan.
