






Lot Sizes (from May meeting)




Zone 1 - Downtown Core and Small Lots —






Zone 2 - Adjacent Residential areas to the





Zone 3 - Residential areas to Northwest — STEP collection system to gravity system of Zone 1






Zone 4 - Step System to Lift Station






#### Zone 5 - STEP System to Join Zone 3
